Khenchen Konchog Gyaltzen is the founder of several Buddhist centers worldwide, including the Tibetan Meditation Center in Frederick, Maryland. Khenchen is respected and beloved as an accomplished scholar, meditation master, teacher, translator, and author.

The force of karma and the requests of many practitioners combined to bring Khenchen Rinpoche to the United States. By late 1983, the Tibetan Meditation Center was well established in Washington, DC. The original location was the site of innumerable teachings, practices, retreats and ceremonies. In 2001 he received the high honor of being enthroned as *Khenchen* (great abbot).

Khenchen Rinpoche spends a great deal of his time traveling in order to give teachings and lead retreats. A skilled and dedicated translator, he has published many books, including: *Prayer Flags*, *The Garland of Mahamudra Practices*, *In Search of Stainless Ambrosia*, *The Great Kagyu Masters*, *The Jewel Treasury of Advice*, *A Complete Guide to the Buddhist Path*, *The Jewel Ornament of Liberation*, *Calling to the Lama from Afar*, *The Transformation of Suffering* and *The Pearl Rosary*. Khenchen Rinpoche's forthcoming book is *Confusion Dawning into Wisdom*.
